## Resolution

WHEREAS, the Alabama Public Charter School Commission (the "Commission") was established by the Alabama School Choice and Student Opportunity Act of 2015 with a mission to authorize and, when appropriate, renew the charters of high-quality public charter schools in accordance with state law.

WHEREAS, in evaluating and reviewing an application for charter renewal, the Commission is charged with the responsibility of grounding its decision in evidence of the school's performance over the term of the charter contract in accordance with, among other things, the Performance Framework set forth in the charter contract.

WHEREAS, on or before July 15, 2021, the Commission provided certain information and charter renewal application guidance to University Charter School related to its performance over the term of the school's initial charter contract, including, without limitation, a Performance Report, a School Quality Review, and information related to state assessments and reports.

WHEREAS, University Charter School timely submitted a renewal application on September 27, 2022.

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2022, the Commission held a public hearing on University's renewal application at which additional evidence, materials, and information in support of renewal were presented to the Commission.

WHEREAS, the Commission is most appreciative of the efforts of University Charter School in the work it has performed over the course of its initial charter term and in the evidence submitted in supported of its renewal application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Alabama Public Charter School Commission does hereby renew the charter of University Charter School to operate a public charter school in Sumter County, Alabama.

## BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. University Charter School has demonstrated competence, capacity, and compliance in each element of the Commission's established renewal criteria and has satisfactorily met or exceeded the performance expectations set forth in University Charter School's charter contract (or where there was a deficiency or weakness related to performance expectations, University Charter School has satisfactory explained the reason for the deficiency and/or has provided the Commission with a satisfactory plan for improvement and compliance). The Commission's findings in this regard are supported, in part, by the Performance Report and the School Quality Review, which are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. University Charter School has further demonstrated additional indicators of strength and exceptional circumstances justifying the continued operation of the school, namely through the successful implementation of its mission to be an innovative, rural, and diverse school that offers a rigorous and integrated Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics focused, project-based and place-based curriculum.

3. University Charter School's charter to operate a public charter school is renewed for a five-year term, consistent with Ala. Code § 16-6F-8(c)(1).
